

He was briefly a minister in the Labour government circa 1930 and was a promoter of disarmament, social justice and women's rights (he was an associate of Emmeline Pankhurst). He was elected to Parliament in 1910 but resigned his position in 1912. He apparently assisted in establishing the Daily Herald newspaper becoming its editor. He was a colourful character and served time in prison with numerous fellow councillors for their involvement in the Poplar Rates Rebellion of 1921. In his latter years he travelled in the United States and Europe encouraging peace and disarmament. In his early, formative years, the promised better prospects tempted him to travel to Australia, en route experiencing near disaster in an epic storm. The prospects were unfortunately unfounded and, in May 1885, he returned to the U.K. the fare having been footed by his father-in-law, for whom he subsequently worked for a time in his timber business, simultaneously campaigning against the misleading information promulgated by the the colonial emigration agents. The story of Lansbury's life, with its dramatic changes of fortune, would make an excellent subject for a film or indeed a series.
